



"HEALTH NUGGET"

The myth is busted! Sunshine protects against a very deadly form of skin cancer called melanoma. People who spend 4-5 hours in the sun each day on weekends are less likely to develop melanoma than those who don't. (The key is to avoid sunburn!) Ten or 15 minutes in noontime summer sun leads to the production of 10,000 IU of vitamin D, which has proven to decrease the risk of many can-

cers. Women with high sun exposure had half the risk of developing advanced breast cancer. Also, reduced risk of other cancers by sunshine include prostate, colon, lung, ovary, bladder, uterus, esophagus, stomach, pancreas, kidney, multiple myeloma, and non-Hodgkin's lymphoma.

EASTER SUNDAY BRUNCH BAKE

Ingredients: 1 doz. eggs; 2 pkgs. Morningstar Farms Sausage Links, sliced; 1 onion, chopped; 8 oz. shredded cheddar cheese; 1/3 cup sour cream; 1 cup fresh sliced mushrooms; 2 tomatoes, diced

Directions: Heat oven to 400 degrees. Whisk eggs and sour cream until



blended; pour into sprayed 13x9-inch baking dish. Bake 10 minutes until softly set. Meanwhile, saute mushrooms, onion, and links on medium heat 6 minutes or so. Reduce oven to 325 degrees. Spoon tomatoes over egg layer; cover with sausage mixture and cheese. Bake 30 minutes or until knife comes out clean. Enjoy!
