

VEGE-TURKEY, CHERRY, & ALMOND PASTA SALAD

Ingredients: 1 lb. bowtie pasta; 2 cups cubed vege-turkey roll; 1/2 cup red onion, diced; 1/2 cup chopped celery; 1 cup almond slivers, toasted; 1 cup dried cherries; 1 cup cheese, cubed; 4 lg. fresh basil leaves, finely chopped; 12 oz. poppy-seed dressing; seasoned salt & pepper

Directions: Cook pasta; drain and rinse with cold water. Set aside. In a



large bowl add turkey, onion, celery, almonds, dried cherries, cheese, and basil. Toss to mix. Add cooled pasta and gently toss. Add seasoned salt and pepper to taste. Add poppy-seed dressing and mix gently to coat all ingredients. Cover and refrigerate up to an hour before serving. Enjoy!


