



GREEK STUFFED AVOCADO

Ingredients: 2 lg. avocados, halved & pitted; 8 cherry tomatoes, halved; 2 tbsp. finely chopped red onion; 2 tbsp. black olives, chopped; 1/2 Persian cucumber, cubed; 1/4 cup feta, cubed; 2 tsp. coarsely chopped fresh dill; 2 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil; 1 tbsp. lemon juice; salt & pepper

Directions: In a medium bowl, toss together tomatoes, red onion,



olives, cucumber, feta, dill, olive oil, and lemon juice. Season with salt and pepper. Scoop out each avocado half, leaving 1/2" border. Cut removed avocado into bite-size pieces and stir into prepared salad. Generously fill each avocado half and serve immediately. Enjoy!




SERMON NOTES



9. LIFE, DEATH, AND RESURRECTION OF CHRIST

In Christ's life of perfect obedience to God's will, His suffering, death, and resurrection, God provided the only means of atonement for human sin, so that those who by faith accept this atonement may have eternal life, and the whole of creation may better understand the infinite and holy love of the Creator. This perfect atonement vindicates the righteousness of God's law and the graciousness of His character; for it both condemns our sin and provides for our forgiveness. The death of Christ is substitutionary and expiatory, reconciling and transforming. The resurrection of Christ pro-

claims God's triumph over the forces of evil, and for those who accept the atonement assures their final victory over sin and death. It declares the Lordship of Jesus Christ, before whom every knee in heaven and on earth will bow.
