

CHICKPEA SALAD SANDWICH

Ingredients: 4 tbsp. mayonnaise; 3 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil; 2 tbsp. salsa verde (optional); 1 tsp. finely grated lemon zest; 1 tbsp. lemon juice; 1 shallot, quartered; 1 garlic clove, halved; 16-oz. can chickpeas, rinsed; 1 medium cucumber, finely chopped; 3 tbsp. crumbled feta; 1/4 cup chopped cilantro; 1/4 cup chopped parsley; 1/2 tsp. salt; 1/8 tsp. black pepper; 1 avocado, thinly sliced; 4 brioche buns, toasted; 1/2 cup baby spinach leaves

Directions: Whisk mayo, oil, salsa verde, lemon zest, and juice in medium



bowl until smooth. Pulse shallot and garlic in food processor until finely chopped. Add chickpeas and pulse coarsely, about 20 seconds. Pour into bowl with salsa verde mixture and fold in cucumber, feta, cilantro, and parsley. Season with salt & pepper. Layer avocado slices on bottom bun, top with chickpea mixture and spinach leaves.

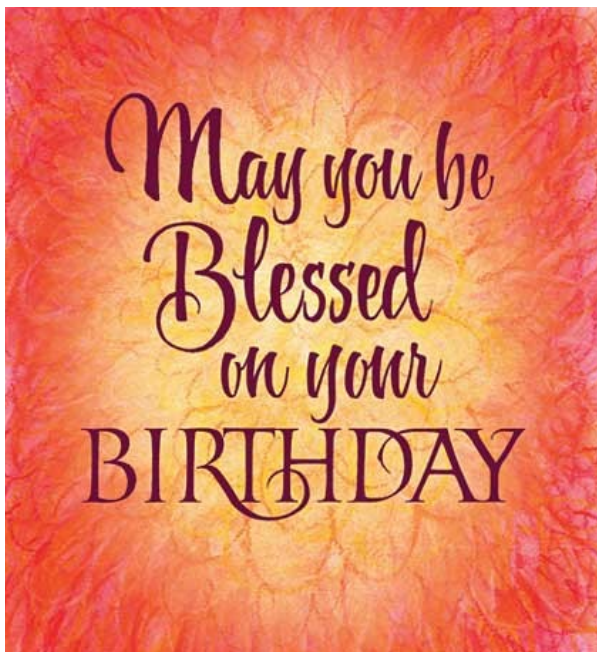
